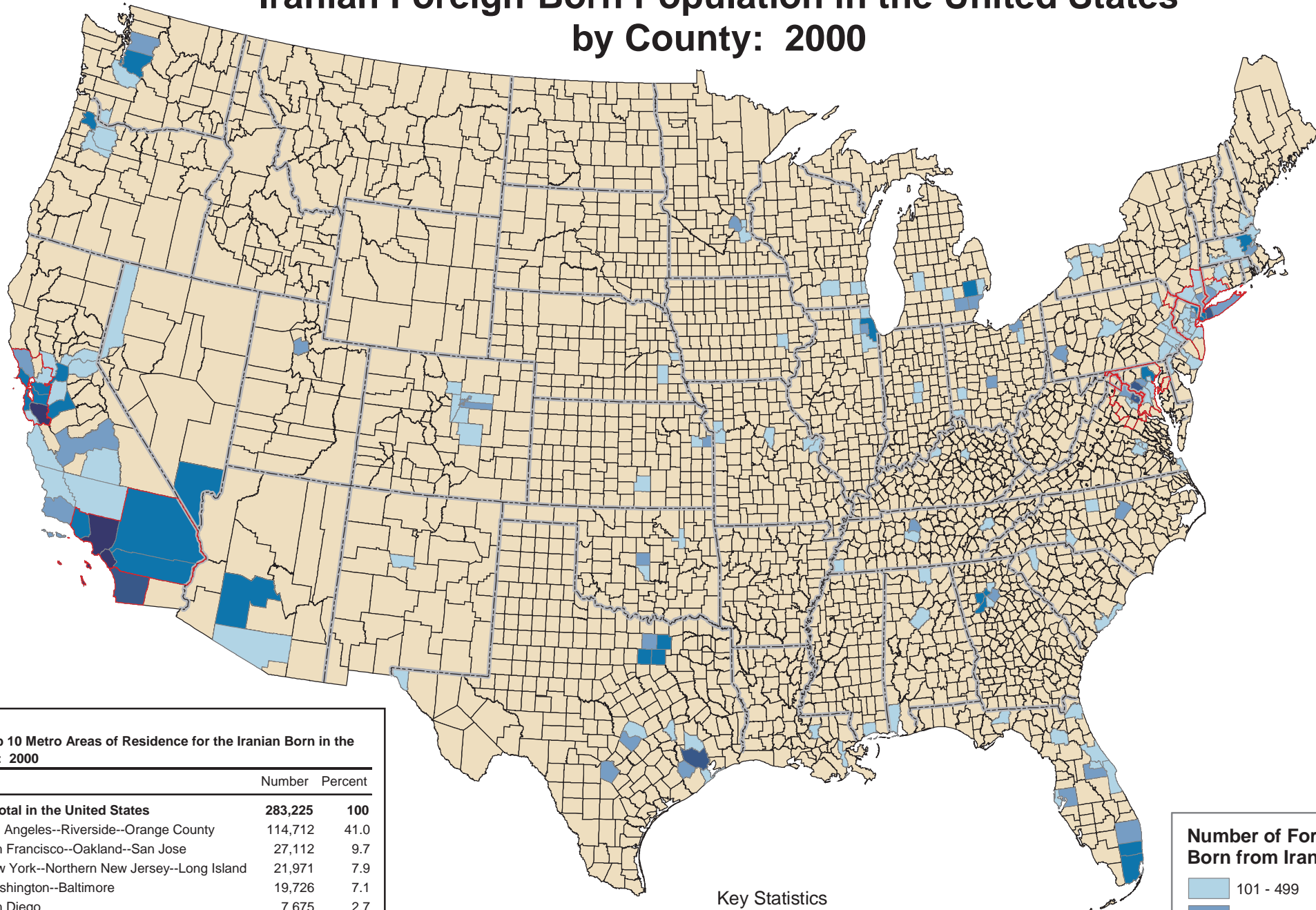


# Iranian Foreign-Born Population in the United States by County: 2000

## Key Statistics

In 2000, there were 283,225 Iranian-born individuals living in the United States.

The states with the largest Iranian-born population are California (55.9 percent), New York (6.1 percent), and Texas (5.5 percent).

Two in every five of Iranian foreign born live in the Los Angeles metropolitan area.
